The poster selection will take place in two phases described below.

=== Poster ===

What we expect from your poster

A poster presenting a **new idea** (recently published or, even better, under development) that provides an overview of the most innovative activities of the laboratory. Tell us something *new*, perhaps even *incomplete* and/or *experimental*, but capable of arousing curiosity and demonstrating the innovative potential of the Institute.

Particularly welcome are proposals led by **young researchers**, well integrated into the laboratory's research activities. On the other hand, what we are **not** looking for is the description of already consolidated and well-known projects.

Each laboratory, where possible, **is invited to contribute with 1–3 posters** to ensure a broad coverage of the Institute's activities.

Applications for Pre-selection

Applications should be sent to poster@isti.cnr.it, indicating:

- Title
- Authors of the poster (specifying the corresponding author)
- Abstract (max 300 words)
- Three (3) relevant #hashtags

Applications must be submitted no later than **October 10**.

Pre-selection

The contributions will be pre-selected by a jury composed of senior members of the Institute.

Notificaton

Authors of accepted contributions will be notified no later than **October 17** and may then proceed with the creation of the poster.

Poster creation guidelines

The guidelines for creating the poster will be sent, together with a possible template, along with the acceptance notification.

Poster submission deadline

Posters must be sent in **.pdf format** no later than **November 3** to poster@isti.cnr.it.

Presentation format

The posters will be displayed on stands set up in **Room A29**, and the author(s) will have the opportunity to introduce their poster to attendees during the dedicated one-hour session.

Archiving and dissemination

The posters and their associated abstracts will be collected and uploaded to **IRIS**.
